What are social fundraisers?

Parties or gatherings hosted by a few (usually 1-6) families that raise money for Cossitt's PTC. Ideally parties for the full school year are scheduled by October.

What's the purpose?

Social Fundraisers build community and financially support our PTC. They help build community by connecting parents in relaxed, social settings. The parties are hosted by groups of Cossitt Parents who cover the cost of the event and tickets are sold to each event where the funds go directly to the PTC.

What are the costs?

- \$25 per guest: Costs for the hosts of these parties are minimal. Examples are the annual shopping event at Vintage Charm, Daley Method and the dad's bike ride.
- \$50 per guest: Most parties fall into this category. Each host spends around \$150+. Theme parties like Havana Nights, Coachella, Studio 54, and wine parties typically fall into this category.
- \$75 per guest: Premium Events that include a take home product and an event; examples Bloom3 or Vagabond
