GENERAL INFORMATION**



Classes are from 8:30AM to 11 AM on four consecutive Saturdays. The dates are 1/28, 2/4, 2/11, and 2/18.

Classes are held at Ogden School, 501 W. Ogden Avenue, La Grange. The school is located five streets west of La Grange Road on the north side of Ogden Avenue.

Given the nature of the classes and the students served, a very high level of behavioral standards is expected for the benefit of everyone.

Registration fee is \$79 for a 4 Saturday class for all students (including those who reside outside of District 102.) **PAYMENT MUST ACCOMPANY REGISTRATION.** Make checks payable to District 102. There is a \$10 discount on the 4 week classes, if postmarked by Friday, December 16, 2011.

Registration for the soccer one Saturday classes is \$20 per class. There is no discount on these classes.

Classes must have a minimum of 7 students. The maximum will be 12 students. Notification of classes that are canceled due to low enrollment will be made by Tuesday, January 24, 2012 via a telephone call.

**Target Grades:** 3-6 **Session:** A-D

**International Exploration** - Spend your Saturday's just like other kids around the world! Each day we will learn about kids who are a lot like you and what they do for fun. Play games, master puzzles, experience literature, and use geography tools to learn about a variety of cultures.

**Target Grades:** 2-4 **Session:** A-D

**Origami Enthusiasm** - Come find out what has made this ancient Japanese art form pass the test of time. It's incredible to watch an ordinary piece of paper transforming into a three dimensional form. The more complex the design - the more incredible this process becomes!

Soccer drills that focus on shooting and dribbling will follow the number lessons. This class will be staffed by former Division I college soccer players. Students should wear athletic clothing and gym shoes or indoor soccer shoes. During the last 20 minutes of class parents are invited to view a skills demonstration.

**Target Grades:** K-2 **Session:** A (Sign up for all 4 soccer classes - “Soccer from All Angles”.)

**Soccer Science and Soccer Offense** - Students will spend time learning about force and motion in soccer. Soccer drills that focus on passing and offense will follow the science lesson. This class will be staffed by former Division I college soccer players. Students should wear athletic clothing and gym shoes or indoor soccer shoes. During the last 20 minutes of class parents are invited to view a skills demonstration.

**Target Grades:** K-2 **Session:** B (Sign up for all 4 soccer classes - “Soccer from All Angles”.)

**Soccer Strategy , Defense, and Team Play** - Students will spend time learning about team strategy in soccer. Students will participate in soccer drills that focus on defense and game plays. This class will be staffed by former Division I college soccer players. Students should wear athletic clothing and gym shoes or indoor soccer shoes. During the last 20 minutes of class parents are invited to view a skills demonstration.

**Target Grades:** K-2 **Session:** C (Sign up for all 4 soccer classes - “Soccer from All Angles”.)

**Futbol, Football, or Soccer?** - Students will spend time learning about how soccer is played around the world. Teams will be formed to create a mini World Cup Championship. This class will be staffed by former Division I college soccer players. Students should wear athletic clothing and gym shoes or indoor soccer shoes. During the last 20 minutes of class parents are invited to view a skills demonstration.
