Students will learn the Chemistry of Clay while they create a clay creature. Clay is a naturally occurring polymer of minerals that exhibits plasticity when wet, but changes physically and chemically when heat is applied in the kiln.

Kids will use their creativity to design and build a clay animal. Creatures will be sent to Village Potters for firing in the kiln. Finished creatures can be picked up at Village Potters, 333 N. LaGrange Rd in LaGrange Park about 2 weeks after class.

Program space is limited. We will try to accommodate every request but will employ a district-wide lottery if necessary.
