

## **2nd GRADE – CCC Ellis Island – Statue of Liberty and Frederic Auguste Bartholdi**

*Please note – this activity must be done as described as it is part of the CCC decoration*

### **Lesson**

Discuss the history and symbolism of the Statue of Liberty and information about its sculptor Frederic Auguste Bartholdi

### **Supplies**

- 8.5” x 11” Light Green Cardstock
- Color photograph head shots of each student
- Glue Sticks
- Pencils
- Medium Point Black Markers
- Gold Glitter Glue
- ¼” Paintbrush

### **Activity**

***Note this project requires advance coordination with the teacher and at home preparation***

### **Statue of Liberty Drawings**

#### **In Advance**

- Arrange for teacher to take a picture of each student’s face and print a copy (~2.5” x 2”)
- Cut each face and glue it to the green card stock, centered, ~3” from top

#### **In Classroom**

- Using pencil, have each student follow the step-by-step instructions to sketch the statue of liberty around their face
- Have student put their name on the back of the artwork
- Have student trace over pencil with black marker once complete
- Use glitter glue to fill in the torch – this can be done by the adult volunteers quickly with paintbrushes
- Leave art with the teach

### **Statue of Liberty Symbolism Match – if time permits**

- Have students pair up to complete the Statue of Liberty Symbolism matching worksheet
