

## 6<sup>th</sup> GRADE – CUBISM

### Lesson

The use of abstract, fragmented shapes to depict several views of the same subject simultaneously, emphasizing the basic geometry or structure of a subject.

### Supplies

- Black thin marker (students should have in classroom)
- Oil pastels
- Sharp pencil for tracing
- Dice
- Wipes
- “Roll a Picasso” sheet (make copies from template in folder)
- Empty portrait sheet (make copies from template in folder)

### Activity – Roll a Picasso

1. Each student rolls the dice five times.
2. Each roll will correspond with a feature on the “roll a Picasso” sheet that they should add to their head (skip the first roll options for head shape since that was provided).
3. All features should be drawn (or traced) with the flair.
4. Add hair/ears/accessories and other features.
5. Color with oil pastels to complete their portrait.
6. Collect dice and offer wipes to cleanup.
